

## **BHEL Achieves Strong Revenue Growth and Record Order Inflows in FY 2024–25**

**New Delhi, April 20:** Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL), India's foremost engineering and manufacturing enterprise in the energy and infrastructure sector, has registered a revenue of Rs.27,350 Crore (provisional and unaudited) for FY 2024–25, marking a robust growth of around 19% over the previous year. The company also secured its highest-ever order inflows during the year, amounting to Rs.92,534 Crore. With this, BHEL's total order book at the end of FY 2024–25 stands at Rs.1,95,922 Crore.
