BHEL Signs MoU with Govt. of Tajikistan for setting up a 100 MW Hydro-Electric Power Project in the Republic of Tajikistan

Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (**BHEL**) has signed an agreement with the Ministry of Energy and Industry, Republic of Tajikistan to set up a 100 MW Hydro Electric Power Plant in Tajikistan. In the presence of H.E. Mr. Emomali Rahmon, President of Tajikistan and Dr. Farooq Abdullah, Honâ€™ble Union Minister for New and Renewable Energy, Govt. of India, the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed by H.E. Mr. Gul Sherali, the Minister of Energy and Industry, Republic of Tajikistan and **BHEL**. The 100 MW Hydro Electric Power Plant will be set up by **BHEL** on Zeravshan river in Tajikistan, and will help in harnessing Tajikistanâ€™s hydro potential. **BHEL** will use its diverse experience in hydro power plants to offer the optimum techno-economic solution for the project. In Tajikistan, **BHEL** has earlier commissioned a Hydro Generator for Pamir-1 project in Khorog and is presently executing renovation, modernization and uprating of Varzob-1 Hydro Power Project.
