BHEL's CSR POLICY STATEMENT

BHEL, a global engineering enterprise providing solutions for a better tomorrow, is committed towards holistic welfare of the society by undertaking CSR activities within the ambit of Schedule-VII of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended from time to time. However, thrust areas for CSR activities will be:

I. Clean India:

Sanitation and making available Safe Drinking Water, Cleaning and preserving the Rivers, Clean surroundings, toilets in schools especially for girls;

II. Educated India:

Promoting education with thrust on informal education to reduce dropouts at primary school level, value education, digital education;

III. Green India:

Ensuring environmental sustainability with emphasis on projects based on Solar Energy;

IV. Healthy India:

Promoting health care including preventive health care and sports;

V. Heritage India:

Protection of national heritage, art and culture;

VI. Inclusive India:

Mitigation of hunger and poverty through livelihood promotion/augmenting income generation, Imparting vocational skills;

VII. Responsible India:

Women Empowerment, Setting up Old Age homes, Day Care Centre and such other facilities for senior citizens, Rural Development Projects and Slum Development Projects;

In the above thrust areas priority will be given to underprivileged, neglected and weaker sections of the society. The company shall give preference to the local areas for spending at least 75% of the amount earmarked for CSR activities. The remaining amount may be utilised beyond local areas. However, contribution made to the Central Government Schemes, where defining the area as well as the scope is not possible for the company, will be excluded while arriving at the 75:25 ratio.

It is desirable that CSR initiatives should be taken up in project mode, to the extent possible. However, it shall exclude any contribution made to the Central Government Schemes. Periodic review of this policy shall be done to ensure its continued suitability, adequacy and efficacy.

In addition to the seating provisions made for schools, BHEL, Industrial Valves Plant (IVP), Goindwal unit further ventured to help a school with clean drinking water facility by providing them with 4 sets of water coolers along with UV based water filters.

This support would ensure that children have access to clean and cold drinking water in their school premises. Most of these schools are operating with mid-day meal scheme and providing clean drinking water is an added advantage for improving the overall health and hygiene of the children.

IVP took upon the challenge of improving the school dropout rate in the elementary schools of the region by focusing on the basic amenities available in the schools. Four Schools were identified which lacked basic seating

facilities for the kids (aged between 8-12 years). IVP provided 230 twin seating benches in these schools. It was very much appreciated by the happy looking children who had no alternative but to sit on dusty rugs on the floor during hot summers and chilling winters. The benches were designed/custom built with the elementary school children in mind.

Green India

Under this head around 200 saplings were planted in two schools. Shri A.V. Krishnan, ED, BHEL-Trichy launched the tree plantation drive on 18.09.2014 in the presence of officials and employees of IVP-Goindwal, teachers and children of the schools.

Another area of concern in these rural schools is lack of playground equipment due to which children played in the dirt and, therefore, the element of fun was missing in them. IVP unit looked into this issue and supplied some sturdy playground equipment to these schools.

After carrying out an assessment, 5 playgrounds were identified where swings, see saws, merry-go-rounds, climbing ladders, and slides were installed.

As per feedback received from Heads of these schools there has been a significant reduction in drop outs and there is an increase in admission rate to these schools as compared to previous years.

The SPV at second academy was also commissioned in March 2015.

IVP teamed up with local Red Cross Society in providing 50 Tri Cycles and 4 Wheel chairs for making life a bit easier for differently-abled people.

Construction of Bio-digester Toilet Cluster with Clean drinking water facility: BHEL under its CSR initiative signed an agreement with FICCI to construct 25 clusters of Bio-digester toilets along the Ganga River from Haridwar upto Rishikesh.

These toilets, based on the DRDO technology, will help reduce the problems of sanitation due to human waste. Under this initiative, clean filtered drinking water will also be available to the public at all these locations.

Construction of Girls toilet at Rashtriya Inter College Aurangabad : At Rashtriya Inter college Aurangabad, two numbers of girls toilets were constructed. The project handed over to the College authorities.

Educational Fellowship support to 100 girl students from weaker Socio-economic background: Educational Fellowship support to 100 girl students from weaker socio-economic background over a period of six(6) years in Hardwar, Uttarakhand" through the specialized agency / NGO named "Udayan Care". An agreement to this effect was signed between BHEL-Hardwar and

Udayan Care in October, 2012 to carry forward this initiative for six years. 100 girls have been selected under this program after undergoing a detailed process of qualification/ selection for scholarship support to the girl children up to post-graduation level.

Agastya Mobile Science lab: A mobile science lab was launched on 22.07.2015 by ED, BHEL-Haridwar, Shri Prakash Chand. This mobile lab (van) will be run through M/s Agastya International Foundation, Bangalore. The objective of this initiative is to generate curiosity and interest in science for the students from class VI to class X of schools that primarily have children from economically weaker sections (EWS) of the society.

The van is equipped with various science models by the help of which it will be easier to make the children understand the concept of science. The mobile science lab will cover nearby schools in the vicinity of BHEL-Haridwar and will run for a period of 3 years.

With the help of local administration, BHEL-Haridwar replaced old lighting systems with LED lights at Har Ki Pauri. Installation of LED lights will not only provide brighter lighting in the area but will also result in saving significant amount of electricity.

Healthy India

Mobile Medical Van Program with the help of PHD Rural Development Foundation: Giving emphasis to the general health of people around BHEL-Hardwar, the unit's CSR group identified a project for providing medical help to the rural poor and slum dwellers around BHEL-Hardwar in alliance with the NGO named 'PHD Rural Development Foundation. The Project started in Feb, 2013 and will be completed by Jan, 2016.

The project aims to provide preventive, clinical and diagnostic medical care to the rural people and slum dwellers of Hardwar and its nearby areas, to act as a pathological lab for spot diagnosis of the diseases, to provide education against drug abuse and to create awareness among community youth and representatives of industrial houses in family planning activity, prevention of HIV/AIDS, nutrition, sanitation, reproductive and child health, female feticide, etc.

PHD foundation covered many villages of Hardwar and collected detailed information on health care by

interviewing important and active persons of those villages. The findings of this survey was that the 'main occupation of the villagers is daily wage earning at different places. They are just hand to mouth without any sustainable avenues of earning/livelihood generation facilities in their lives. These villagers are economically and socially under-developed and, therefore, cannot afford for their health management/medical needs on their own.

Financial support for Ganga Prem Hospice: BHEL-Haridwar, is partnering with M/s Shraddha Cancer Care Trust for construction of a 30-bed Hospice named Ganga Prem Hospice in Rishikesh which will provide free of charge inpatient medical care for terminally ill cancer Patients.

This Project started in Jan 2014 and will be completed by Jul 2016. Ganga Prem Hospice will serve an estimated 200+ long & short stay terminally ill cancer patients in a year .Out inpatients beneficiaries are estimated at 5500 per year at its full capacity. A team of health care professionals and volunteers will provide medical, psychological, and spiritual resources to the cancer patients. Ganga Prem Hospice will function in a peaceful place in Rishikesh, with a picturesque view of the surrounding hills, giving in-patients the physical comfort and security of a palliative care facility.

Construction of Physiotherapy Hall for Old Age People in Shivalik Nagar: Physiotherapy Centre built by BHEL-Haridwar under CSR at Shivalik Nagar is being used by old age people of the area. The average patients per day are between 45 to 50.





Awareness programmes on Climate Change and Clean Ganga mission are being held in 18 schools through IASRD. In the programs, the school students are encouraged to learn, understand and address the impacts of global warming and the efforts needed to stop them. The programme not only makes them aware but also encourages them to change their attitudes and behaviour for a more sustainable path in the future.

Healthy India

Eye checkup and cataract surgery camps were organised at nine (9) locations in and around NCR with a total OPD of around 1115 patients out of which 116 cataract surgeries were done. All expenditure for operations, food and stay of the patients at hospital, dark glasses and post-operative medicines were borne by BHEL without any cost to the patients.

Another Eye Checkup and cataract surgery camp were organised in Chuari & Tissa (H.P). The patients were screened by doctors for eye ailments and free medicines were also distributed to the needy. Also, patients with cataracts were operated at Rotary Eye Hospital, Maranda, Palampur, HP. All costs towards surgery, food, medicines, bus fare, etc were borne by BHEL. In all, a total OPD of 250 and 45 surgeries were done.

Educated India

To help children in getting clean drinking water, RO water purifiers are being installed in six (6) rural schools near the vicinity of PSNR sites as part of infrastructure development in schools through the NGO named TWI. These RO water purifiers work on dual energy source (solar and electric) and will help solve the problem of clean drinking water for the school children.

Safe drinking water reduces waterborne diseases; improves the lives of women; increases attendance at schools, particularly of the girl children, who often have responsibility for fetching/collecting water; and improves the overall health and productivity of communities.

The project's foremost objective was to bring safe, affordable drinking water to the underserved rural communities in 10 villages of Bhandara district of Maharashtra by way of setting up of Safe Water Station equipped with Remote Monitoring System. The underlying purpose includes easy, reliable access to safe

drinking water at affordable price to improve their health and reduce the incidence of waterborne diseases in the villages.

Setting up/support to schools at Nagpur district by providing safe drinking water facility: Under this project, BHEL-PSWR has installed RO water purifiers in the six Zilla Parishad schools of Nagpur District, Maharashtra. The work has been executed through M/s AGVSS, Amravati. The 6 Schools are located in: Kelwad, Isapur, Walni, Pipala, Khairi Dhalgaon & Bhendala villages of Nagpur district.

As a result of this project initiative by PSWR, the children now have safe, pure drinking water facility in their school premises itself. Earlier, the children had to depend on water supplied through Gram Panchayat water tanks which is not regularly chlorinated and the supply too was uncertain.

Cataract operation for 200 people through 'HelpAge India': Under this project, PSWR supported the Intra Ocular Lens (IOL) cataract surgeries for 200 underprivileged people from Nagpur and adjoining

Organized a "multi specialty camp" in collaboration with hospital (Hanumant Hospital) in nearby villages of Pipavav Site (Gujarat): A multi-speciality Camp" in collaboration with Hanumant Hospital at Kovaya village in the vicinity of BHEL PSWR Pipavav site was organized. The event was planned to help the needy persons of this area to get free consultation, primary treatment at site and patients who required further

A total of 460 patients were examined by the doctors. ECG, RBS, Rubella vaccination for girls, and other tests were also provided in the camp. 100 patients referred to Hanumant Hospital for further treatment and a total of 13 surgeries were conducted on the needy patients.

Organizing a "multi specialty medical camp" at Nagpur for underprivileged children: Under CSR head - health care including preventive health care - PSWR organised a multi-speciality camp in collaboration with M/s Hope Hospital, Nagpur for the underprivileged children from the slum and backward areas of the Nagpur (Maharashtra). A team of Specialist doctors with supporting paramedical staff examined the children and provided the required medicines to the needy at Lokhande Nagar, Nagpur. The project aims at restoring 10 acres of degraded land area through scientifically sound and tested methods; protecting the area from poachers, illegal miners, wood cutters, grazers and other encroachers; enhancing the existing and seasonal wetlands for the benefit of wildlife and local communities. Around 10000 saplings were planted in the project area during 2012-13. This prestigious CSR project is inclusive of maintenance of the saplings for five years.

The indigenous and ecologically important plants have acclimatized to the land and have a healthy growth. The plants have attained a height of 6 to 12 feet with the trunk girth of 10 to 18 inches. Birds species like, Red-vented Bulbul, Laughing Dove, Prinias, Babblers, Munias, etc. are building their nests in these planted trees. Other ground nesting birds like Grey Francolin, Larks, Quails, Pipits etc. have been making nests on the ground covered with grass in the plantation zone. Apart from that, many other bird species have been seen roosting on the area restored through BHEL's endeavor.

Healthy India

Through HelpAge India, Mobile Medicare Unit (MMU) is operated in Angul District, Odisha wherein it is rendering mobile health services to the community at their doorsteps in Kaniha Block of Angul District. The MMU visits weekly & provides preventive health care and free medication to the elderly of the community. This programme addresses the inaccessibility, inability to afford and non-availability of basic health care

services to the community particularly the poor & needy elderly. Besides health check-up, treatment and follow-up services, the MMU generates awareness in the community on various issues like old age problems, hygiene, sanitation etc. Day-to-day operations of the MMU is monitored by PSSR – Angul Site.

Bellary site completed a CSR Project during the year with a focus on the thrust area – Healthy India. The site provided a Diagnostic Center in Kudathini Village. As part of this CSR Project initiative, the site constructed buildings for the diagnostic center and also provided lab equipment for the same. The day-to-day operation and maintenance of the diagnostic center would be carried out by Public Health Center in the village.

The CSR project - "Distribution of Mobility Aids to Differently-abled persons" was completed by PSSR Neyveli Site. In this project, a psychiatrist and rehabilitation specialist visited the village and conducted an assessment camp for the disabled persons, wherein the measurements were taken for customized appliances. Later, a distribution camp was held wherein the mobility aids or calipers, were distributed. More than 100 persons benefitted through this CSR Project.

Inclusive India

Equipments for vocational training were provided to "Pragati Institute for reformation of mentally challenged persons" through an NGO based in Secunderabad. The institute trains more than 30 students in vocational activities to make the students self-reliant. The project was completed by PSSR – SAS, Secunderabad.

Responsible India

In Chennai, lab equipment were provided to Little Drops Composite Health Services. The center extends medical services to the inmates of an Old age Home and also provide affordable healthcare to the needy around the center. 

BHEL supports Global Cancer Concern India (GCCI) for providing palliative care to terminally ill cancer patients in Delhi/NCR: BHEL has entered into a noble CSR initiative to alleviate the suffering and pain of terminally ill cancer patients who are battling with this deadly disease. An agreement to the effect was signed between BHEL- ASSCP, Gurgaon with Global Cancer Concern India (GCCI) on 12th September 2013 at ASSCP unit, Gurgaon to carry forward this initiative for a period of 2 years. Under this project, palliative care will be extended to a minimum of 80 people per month and also around 800 people to be covered under the cancer screening programme. The project is named Palliative therapy through palliative clinic and mobile unit. The main objective of the project is to support the patients and their families medically, socially, emotionally and spiritually. The project aims at serving the terminally ill cancer patients irrespective of their religion, caste or race. GCCI team will be visiting the patients at their homes and provide them counseling to overcome the pain & trauma of the dreaded disease.

The project is being implemented by GCCI by various modes including:

a. Day-Care centre: Patients come to the day-care centre of GCCI and they are treated and provided medicines free of cost. Apart from the medication, they are also provided with diagnostic facilities for Pathological tests such as Pap



- b. Mobile Unit: GCCI presently is provided with two mobile unit, which is used to visit the patients in nearby areas who cannot come to day care centre's for Palliative care.
- Medical Camps: GCCI has conducted four cancer detection camps at nearby villages and affected areas including Bandhwari, Gwalpahari, Nathupur and Badshahpur.

The project is nearing its completion and has so far tried to bring change to the lives of the terminally ill cancer patients who are under privileged and do not have necessary financial resources and emotional strength to deal with the disease.







