Any clarification/ query received after last date for seeking clarification may not normally be entertained by BHEL and no time extension will be given.
- iii. In the event of any conflict between requirement of any clause of this specification/ documents/ drawings/ data sheets etc. or requirements of different codes/ standards specified, the same to be brought to the knowledge of BHEL in writing for clarification before due date of seeking clarification, otherwise, interpretation by BHEL shall prevail. Any typing error/ missing pages/ other clerical errors in the tender documents, noticed must be pointed out before pre-bid meeting/ submission of offer else BHEL's interpretation shall prevail.
