Kasturba Hospital, BHEL Bhopal invites tender for outsourcing of collection, transportation & Incineration of Bio- medical waste including covid waste of Kasturba Hospital BHEL, Bhopal for a **period of one year.** The bid will be in two-part system (Part-I is the Techno- Commercial Bid and Part-II is Price Bid).

Part – I and Part – II bids should be put in separately sealed envelopes and each envelope must be marked clearly as Techno-commercial Bid or Price Bid as the case may be. NIT Number and bidder's Name & Address should also be clearly mentioned on these envelopes. These two envelopes must be put in a bigger envelope and sealed properly. Top of the outer cover / envelope should contain following information:

- 1. NIT No. & Title of Work
- 2. Bid opening date & time
- 3. Address / Venue of Bid submission
- 4. Bidder's name & Address

5. All the pages of NIT issued are to be signed by authorized signatory and submitted along with technical bid

SCOPE OF WORK:

 During the process of functioning, Bio Medical Wastes generated, has to be disposed safely as per the norms of the Bio Medical Waste (MH) Rule 1998 or as desired by the nodal agency i.e. M.P. Pollution Control Board, Bhopal (MPPCB) Govt. of Madhya Pradesh.

- 2. The party will collect the Bio Medical wastes of the Kasturba Hospital and four peripheral health Clinics located at Habibganj Health Clinic, Piplani Health Clinic, Govindpura Health Clinic, MGM Health Clinic including OHS (Factory Medical Block), transport them to the site of their incineration and incinerate them by the use of a suitable incinerator.
- 3. In addition, Covid-19 waste generated in wards identified for treatment of covid patient shall also be collected, transported and incinerated as per norms issued by MPPCB.
- 4. The period of contract will be for a period of **one year which may be extended as per BHEL policy on satisfactory completion of work**.

Qualifying Criteria :

a) The incinerators should be authorized by MP Pollution Control Board Bhopal for collection, segregation and incineration of Bio-Medical waste. A valid certificate/license copy in this respect shall be submitted by the bidder.

Terms and conditions for offering tenders are as follows:

- 1. The schedule of collection of Bio Medical Waste (BMW) for the areas mentioned above shall be on daily basis without fail and daily measurement records shall be available with the party which has to be submitted to the hospital on monthly basis.
- 2. The Party has to carry out the BMW incineration work by using suitable standard machines and adapting recommended procedures of the nodal agency.
- 3. It shall be the responsibility of the agency to arrange for all consumable & suitable machines as required for the above purpose.
- 4. Party shall reckon its liability towards the workmen employed by them in this contract and ensure that all applicable labour laws are being complied with. BHEL shall not incur any liability on this account.
- The successful tenderers will have to make Security Deposit as per Works Policy, 2016 of BHEL. The total amount of Security Deposit will be 5% of the contract value.
- 6. The Security Deposit as mentioned in Works Policy 2016, can be deposited in any one of the following forms :

SD may be deposited in electronic mode as per BHEL norms or in the form of Bank Guarantee/Fixed Deposit/ Securities pledged in favour of BHEL.

At least 50% of the required Security Deposit, should be collected before start of the work. Balance of the Security Deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the Contractor till the total amount of the required Security Deposit is collected. Security Deposit shall not carry any interest

Note: Acceptance of Security Deposit against Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act and Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL. However, BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith.

(MSMEs is exempted from submission of Tender Fees on providing valid MSME certificate issued by Competent Authority).

- 8. Techno-commercial Bid in Annexure I & Price Bid in Annexure II should be submitted in 2 separate sealed envelopes clearly mentioning on the top of the envelopes as "I – Techno commercial Bid" & "II – Price Bid".
- 9. That the BMW work is subject to supervision of the authorized staff of the Kasturba Hospital and subject to such time and period specified for each work by the management of BHEL and any irregularity observed or any area left uncleared,

will entail imposition of the penalty of Rs.2000/- by the hospital management per area/ work/ per day, whichever is more appropriate. GST on penalty shall be extra.

- 10. If the contracting work is not satisfactory / not done as per schedule due to any circumstances, the Hospital Bio-waste management work being an emergency work will be done by any alternate agency and the cost paid to other agency including overhead administrative charges @ 20% on cost incurred for the said activities shall be recovered from the party. In the event of unsatisfactory performances or noncompliance of any of the terms and conditions of the contract by the Party, the management of BHEL, shall have the right to terminate the Contract with 15 days advance notice.
- 11. If any controversy regarding performance of the work is there, it has to be settled on the same day to the entire satisfaction of the officer in charge nominated for the above purpose.
- 12. The Party shall take a certificate from the authorized executive of the Kasturba Hospital for satisfactory performance of work on fortnightly basis.
- 13. The Party shall be required to execute an agreement on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of applicable value in the form prescribed by BHEL. The expenses of completing and stamping the agreement shall be borne and paid by the contractor.
- 14. The bill should be submitted by the Party on monthly basis and payments will be made as within 90 days and for MSME parties the payment will be made within 45 days of submission of bills with all required documents. GST shall be payable extra as applicable.
- 15. The Party will be responsible for enforcing all safety regulations applicable to BHEL and is advised to take adequate insurance cover of its representatives, labour and equipment etc
- 16. The precaution should be taken while filling the Price Bid format. In case of overwriting in Price Bid format, the tender/offer submitted by the party will be rejected.
- 17. In case the total rate quoted by two or more parties are same then party who has successfully executed more numbers of work order of similar nature (disposal of Bio-Medical Waste) within the period of one year will get preference.

COMPENSATION:

18. Compensation in cases of death / permanent incapacitation of person due to unintended/unforeseen occurrences during the operation and works incidental thereto at BHEL hospital/offices and precincts thereof during handling, collection, transportation and incineration of Bio medical waste of Kasturba Hospital BHEL-Bhopal.

"BHEL shall recover the amount of compensation paid to victim (s) by BHEL towards loss of life / permanent disability due to an accident which is attributable to the negligence of contractor, agency or firm or any of its employees as detailed below.

a) Victim: Any person who suffers permanent disablement or dies in an accident as defined below.

b) Accident : Any death or permanent disability resulting solely and directly from any unintended and unforeseen injurious occurrence caused during the manufacturing / operation and works incidental thereto at BHEL factories / offices and precincts thereof, project execution, erection and commissioning, services, repairs and maintenance trouble shooting, serving, overhaul renovation and retrofitting, trial operation, performance guarantee testing undertaken by the company or during any works / during working at BHEL Units / Offices / townships and premises / Project Sites.

Compensation in respect of each of the victims:

1. In the event of death or permanent disability resulting from Loss of both limbs – Rs.10, 00,000/- (Rs. Ten Lakh).

2. In the event of other permanent disability – Rs.7, 00,000/- (Rs. Seven Lakh).

Permanent Disablement: A disablement that is classified as a permanent total disablement under the provision to Section 2 (I) of the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923.

- 19. The Party shall supply uniform with all the safety appliances to the person Handling the BMW and the uniform shall be kept in neat, tidy and wearable conditions. The cap shall be integral part of uniform.
- 20. List of man power if deployed, their clear address including the details Particulars of the supervising staff, contact Tele. No. &Address of the responsible nominee of the Contractor to be given to the Hospital authority before execution of the work.

21. All legal issues are to be dealt in Bhopal jurisdiction only.

22. **ARBITRATION AND GOVERNING LAW:** All disputes arising in connection with the contract shall be settled by mutual consultation. If no agreement is reached the dispute shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made thereunder. The dispute shall be referred for arbitration to any arbitrator to be appointed by the Head of the Unit. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the Parties. The venue of the Arbitration shall be Bhopal in India. The Award to be given by the Arbitration shall be a speaking award. All questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with this contract shall be to the exclusive jurisdiction of Bhopal Courts.

23. CONCILIATION CLAUSE FOR CONDUCTING CONCILIATION PROCEEDINGS

The Parties agree that if at any time (whether before, during or after the arbitral or judicial proceedings), any Disputes (which term shall mean and include any dispute, difference, question or disagreement arising in connection with construction, meaning, operation, effect, interpretation or breach of the agreement, contract or the Memorandum of Understanding (delete whichever is inapplicable), which the Parties are unable to settle mutually), arise inter-se the Parties, the same may, be referred by either party to Conciliation to be conducted through Independent Experts Committee to be appointed by competent authority of BHEL from the BHEL Panel of Conciliators.

Notes:

- a) No serving or a retired employee of BHEL/Administrative Ministry of BHEL shall be included in the BHEL Panel of Conciliators.
- b) Any other person(s) can be appointed as Conciliator(s) who is/are mutually agreeable to both the parties from outside the BHEL Panel of Conciliators.

The proceedings of Conciliation shall broadly be governed by Part-III of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification thereof and as provided in Annexure to this GCC.

The Annexure together with it's appendices will be treated as if the same is part and parcel hereof and shall be as effectual as if set out herein in these GCC.

<u>GST</u>

- 1. Wherever bidders are required to supply services at project site Party has to submit GST registration no. of the State in which project site is located along with copy of registration certificate at the time of submission of Bid. In case the same is not available at the time of submission of bid, the contractor has to give an undertaking that the same will be arranged before award of work order.
- 2. HSN Code/SAC, rate of tax under GST and applicable GST (IGST, CGST/SGST/UGST) and GSTIN shall be clearly mentioned by the Bidder.
- 3. GST portion of the **invoice shall be released only upon :-**
 - 2.2.1 All invoices raised by contractors/vendors must be GST complaint Tax invoices as per GST invoice rules.
 - 2.2.2 Contractor declaring such invoice in his GSTR-1 or any modified return as notified by government.
 - 2.2.3 Receipt of good/services and Tax Invoice by BHEL and
 - 2.2.4 Confirmation of payment of GST thereon by contractor on GSTN portal
 - 2.2.5 Alternatively, Contractor has to submit BG of appropriate value which shall be valid at least one month after the confirmation of date of payment of GST by contractor on GSTN portal and receipt of Tax invoice and receipt of services, whichever is later. Contractor has to give an undertaking in this regard.
 - 2.2.6 Contractor has to give an undertaking to BHEL that they have declared invoice in his return and paying GST within timeline prescribed for availing ITC by BHEL.

Payment to Contractor for GST portion will be released only after completion of above activity and on availment of ITC by BHEL.

- 4. In case GST credit is delayed/denied to BHEL due to non/delayed receipt of services/goods and / or tax invoice or expiry of the timeline prescribed in GST Law for availing such ITC, or any other reasons not attributable to BHEL, GST amount shall be recoverable from the contractor along with interest levied/ leviable on BHEL.
- 5.

Reverse Charge under GST

5A. In respect of services, reverse charge liability shall arise at the earliest of date of payment to services provider or 60 days from the date of issue of invoice by service provider. Contractor has to submit bill for payment within 30 days from the date of invoice. Any interest or penalty implications attributable to the contractor shall be recovered from them.

5B. Any GST liability arising on BHEL under reverse charge before actual receipt of goods and/or invoice thereof would be subject to recovery of interest leviable for the period between the date of such liability and actual date of eligibility of ITC based on receipt of goods, receipt of invoices and other condition specified in GST Law.

Liquidated Damage/Penalty

6. Liquidated damage (LD) or Penalty if chargeable from suppliers/contractors as per NIT, applicable GST will be charged in addition to the same.

Tax Deduction at source

7. TDS as per extent provisions of the GST Law shall be deducted from supplier/contractor bill.
