For Supply of High Mast Light to Manuguru

Quantity Required: 12 Nos.

1. Scope:

- 1) The brief scope of work shall include
 - a) Design, engineering, manufacturing, supply, dispatch to site with transit insurance, receipt at site, storage, handling, erection, testing and commissioning of lighting mast, complete in all respects including luminaries at 4x270MW Manuguru Project, India as detailed below. These shall be complying with the Technical Specifications, as detailed below.
 - b) All necessary civil works including design, engineering, construction of foundation, hardware etc.
 - c) BHEL shall provide power supply. The bidder shall carry all further necessary power distribution.
 - d) The location of lighting mast / tower shall be decided at site and bidder has to comply with the same.

2. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION:

- 01. Supply of 30 Meters High Mast system with all accessories including but not restricted to the following.
- a) Mast shaft in two or three sections, hot dip galvanized and suitable for wind velocity as per IS 875 part 3.
- b) Head frame, steel wire rope of min, 6mm dia., double drum winch.
- c) Galvanized Lantern carriage arrangement suitable for 12 nos. Luminaries & its control gear Boxes and Lighting finial.
- d) Integral power tool installed inside base compartment for its operation.
- 02. Supply of 12 nos. non-integral 2x400 watts High Pressure Metal Halide floodlight luminaires with two nos. 400 W High Pressure Metal Halide Lamps in each luminaire and required control gear boxes suitable for operation on 230V, 50HZ, a.c. supply.
- 03. Supply of twin dome aviation obstruction light with 2 nos LED lamps. Make and details about the aviation obstruction light shall be furnished with the offer.
- 04. Supply of control panel housing control circuit for the operation of the mast, precision timer for automatic On/Off control and required controls for the power tool motor.

05. WINCH

The winch shall be of completely self-sustaining type, without the need for brake shoe, springs of clutches. Driving spindle of the winch shall be locked when not in use. The capacity, operating speed, safe working load, recommended lubrication and serial number of the winch shall be clearly marked on the winch.

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The winch drum shall be grooved to ensure perfect seat for stable and tidy rope lay, with no chances of rope slippage. The rope termination in the winch shall be such that distortion is eliminated and at least 5 to 6 turns of rope remains on the drum even when the lantern carriage is fully lowered and rested on the rest pads. It should be possible to operate the winch manually by a suitable handle in-case of problem with electrically operated tool.

06. HEAD FRAME

The head frame, which is to be designed as a unit of the mast, shall be of welded steel construction, galvanised both internally and externally after assembly. The top pulley shall be of appropriate diameter, large enough to accommodate the stainless steel wire rope and the multicore electric cable. The pulley block shall be made of non-corrodible material, and shall be of die cast Aluminium Alloy. Pulley made of synthetic Materials such as Plastic or PVC is not acceptable. Self-Lubricating bearings and stainless steel shaft shall be provided to facilitate smooth and maintenance free operation for a long period. The pulley assembly shall be protected by a canopy galvanized internally and externally, close fitting guides and sleeves shall be provided to ensure that the ropes and cables do not get dislodged from their respective positions in the grooves. The head frame shall be provided with guides and stops with PVC buffer for docking the lantern carriage.

07. LANTERN CARRIAGE

A fabricated MS hot dip galvanized lantern carriage shall be provided for mounting of luminary arm assemblies. The diameter of the lantern carriage shall not be less than 1200 mm.

08. STAINLESS STEEL WIRE ROPES

The High Mast Light has an optimally balanced system for raising and lowering of the luminaries. The suspension system shall be of non-corrodible stainless steel of AISI 316 or better grade. The stainless steel wire ropes shall be of suitable size, the central core being of the same material. The overall diameter of the rope shall not be less than 6mm. Continuous length of stainless steel wire ropes shall be used in the system. There shall be no intermediate joints/ terminations, either bolted or any other type, on the wire ropes.

09. ELECTRICAL SYSTEM, CABLE AND CABLE CONNECTIONS

A suitable terminal box shall be provided at the base compartment of the high mast for terminating the incoming cable. The electrical connections from the bottom to the top shall be made by special trailing cable. Size of the cable shall be minimum 5 core 2.5 sq.mm. Copper. At the top there shall be weather proof junction box to terminate the trailing cable. Connections from the top junction box to the individual luminaries shall be made by using 3 core 1.5 sqmm Copper flexible PVC cables of reputed make. The system shall have inbuilt facilities for testing the luminaries while in lowered position. Also suitable provision shall be made at the base compartment of the mast to facilitate the operation of internally mounted, electrically operated power tool for raising and lowering of the lantern carriage assembly. The trailing cable of the lantern carriage rings shall be terminated by means of metal clad, multi-pin plug and socket provided in the base compartment to enable easy disconnection when required.

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The fitting and control gear boxes offered should be suitable for outdoor application and properly sealed to prevent rain water entry.

10. <u>Luminaries and Lamps</u>

The luminaries and lamp should be of Phillips, Bajaj, GE, Wipro, Crompton Greaves, of any other equivalent make certified by ISI.

11. POWER TOOL FOR THE WINCH:

A suitable, high-powered, electricity driven, internally mounted power tool, with manual over ride shall be supplied for the raising and lowering of the lantern carriages for maintenance purpose. The speed of the power tool shall be to suit the system. The power tool shall be single speed, provided with a motor of the required rating. The power tool shall be supplied complete with suitable control. The capacity and speed of the electric motor used in the power tool shall be suitable for the lifting of the design load installed on the lantern carriage. The power tool mounting shall be so designed that it will be not only self-supporting but also aligns the power tool perfectly with respect to the winch spindle during the operations. Also, a handle for the manual operation of the winches in case of problems with the electrically operated tool shall be provided.

12. LIGHTING ARRESTOR:

One number heavy duty hot dip galvanized lighting spike rod shall be provided for each mast. The lightning spike rod shall be minimum 1.2 M in length and shall be provided at the centre of the head frame. It shall be bolted solidly to the head frame to get a direct conducting path to the earth through the mast.

13. AVIATION OBSTRUCTION LIGHT:

Suitable Aviation Obstruction Lights of reliable design and reputed manufacturer shall be provided on top of each mast.

14. EARTHING TERMINALS:

Suitable earth terminals (Minimum 04 Nos.) shall be provided at a convenient location on the base of the mast, for lighting and electrical Earthing of the mast and Including Earth Links up to each Earth Pits.

15. CONTROL PANEL:

Incoming TPN Switch Fuse Unit with HRC fuses or MCCB of suitable current rating, incoming/outgoing terminals and control for the power motor, suitable digital timer of reputed make, with necessary contactors, wiring for ON/OFF control of the lamps shall be provided in the control panel.

16. RESTING STOPPERS:

Necessary arrangements shall be made to rest the lantern carriage on the stoppers in lowering position. The stoppers should be capable of withstanding the mast weight.

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17. Any other items not described above but required for satisfactory performance of the illumination system are deemed to have been included in the scope of the bidder / contractor at no extra cost implication to owner.

3. Quality Requirement:

Test certificate shall be furnished by the contractor, obtained from the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) for each winch including wire rope, in support of the minimum load operated by the winch.

3.1 Bidder to submit the following information along with the offer:

- 1. Technical details of the mast & accessories offered.

- 3. Minimum & maximum lux level.
- 4. Types of luminaries offered.

PBG confirmation charges shall be borne by vendor.

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7. <u>Inspection Requirements:</u>

8. Contract Execution Bank Guarantee (CEBG)

The successful bidder has to furnish a Contract Execution Bank Guarantee (CEBG) for 10% of the Total PO value in the prescribed format within 30 days from the date of PO but before L/C opening. 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VII. Evaluation Criteria, Loading Criteria and Payment Terms:

1. <u>Tenders</u> will be evaluated on the basis of delivered cost, i.e. total cost to the BHEL, taking into consideration loadings, if any, and all available financial advantages, including those available from Owner, taxation authorities etc. (i.e. CENVAT credit of Excise duty/CVD/Service Tax & VAT credit). Combined value of Supply and Erection & Commissioning will be considered for evaluation.

2. Loading Criteria

Loading factors as detailed below will be added to the quoted price (basic) to evaluate the lowest quote for noncompliance of BHEL standard commercial terms.

A. Liquidated Damages/Penalty:

- ❖ LD shall be 0.5% of the total order value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the total order value.
- ❖ In case bidder is not accepting the penalty clause for delayed supply, the offer of bidder shall be loaded to the extent to which it is not agreed by the bidder during price bid evaluation.

B. For noncompliance of standard Terms of payment (For Indigenous Purchase Orders)

- ❖ Base rate of State Bank of India (SBI) (as applicable on the date of bid opening; Techno-commercial bid opening in case of two part bids) + 6%; shall be considered for loading for the period of relaxation sought by bidders.

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VIII. Reverse Auction Terms & Conditions

BHEL reserves the right to decide the successful bidder on the basis of Reverse Auction process. In such case all qualified bidders will be intimated regarding procedure/ modality for Reverse Auction process prior to Reverse Auction and price will be decided as per the rules for Reverse Auction.

However, if reverse auction process is unsuccessful as defined in the RA rules/procedures, or for whatsoever reason, then the sealed 'PRICE BIDs' will be opened for deciding the successful bidder. BHEL's decision in this regard will be final and binding on bidder.

- 1. Against this enquiry for the subject item/ system with detailed scope of supply as per enquiry specifications, BHEL may resort to "REVERSE AUCTION PROCEDURE" i.e., ON LINE BIDDING (THROUGH A SERVICE PROVIDER). The philosophy followed for reverse auction shall be English Reverse (No ties).

All bidders to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids. In case BHEL decides to go for Reverse Auction, only those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in RA will be allowed to participate in the Reverse Auction. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit "online sealed bid" in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of "online sealed bid" by the bidder will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
- 3. For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
- 4. Those bidders who have given their acceptance for Reverse Auction (quoted against this tender enquiry) will have to necessarily submit 'online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'online sealed bid' by the bidder for any of the eligible items for which techno-commercially qualified, will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
- 5. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on internet.
- 6. In case of reverse auction, BHEL will inform the bidders the details of Service Provider to enable them to contact & get trained.
- 7. Business rules like event date, time, bid decrement, extension etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
- 8. Bidders have to fax the Compliance form (annexure IV) before start of Reverse auction. Without this, the bidder will not be eligible to participate in the event.
- 9. Bidders should acquaint themselves of the "Business Rules of Reverse Auction", which will be communicated before the Reverse Auction.
- 15. If the Bidder or any of his representatives are found to be involved in Price manipulation/ cartel formation of any kind, directly or indirectly by communicating with other bidders, action as per extant BHEL guidelines, shall be initiated by BHEL and the results of the RA scrapped/aborted.
